General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected**. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector, providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number**.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTES AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.
